It is hereby notified that the following are the resolutions of the emergency meeting of the Teachers' Council held on 23.06.2023 to finalize the modalities of admission for academic session 2023-2024 under the Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP) as per NEP, 2020, in view of the revised guidelines published by the University of Burdwan vide Notification No. R-C/UG-Perm/Adm/2 Dated 16-06-2023:

1. The **revised list of choices for allied minors** for students choosing major in various subjects offered by the college for the **Three and Four-Year B.A. and B. Sc. Undergraduate Programmes** is as follows:

SI No	Major	Allied Minor
1	Bengali	English or History or Political Science or Sociology
2	English	Bengali or History or Political Science or Sociology
3	History	English or Bengali or Political Science or Sociology
4	Political Science	English or Bengali or History or Sociology
5	Sociology	English or Bengali or History or Political Science
6	Zoology	Botany or Chemistry

Further, for **Three and Four-Year B.A. Undergraduate Programmes**, the applicants will be required to clearly mention their **first and second preferences** for allied minor among the available choice of four subjects for a particular major. Final decision regarding the allotment of allied minors will be subject to the availability of seats.

For **Four-Year B.Sc. Undergraduate Programme**, the applicants will be required to clearly mention their **first and second preferences** for allied minor from the available choice of Botany and Chemistry. However, allotment of allied minor from the available choice of Botany and Chemistry, will be done on merit basis, with half of the student strength enrolled in the programme assigned Botany and the other half Chemistry.

2. Applicants seeking admission for the **Three and Four-Year B.A. or Four-Year B. Sc. Undergraduate Programmes** in the academic session 2023-2024 under the Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP) as per NEP, 2020, will be permitted by the college to apply for **four options in total**.

For instance, an applicant may apply for **Four-Year B.A. Degree Programme (with Honours) in any three subjects from Bengali, English, History, Pol Science and Sociology, along with Three-Year B.A. Degree Programme in any one subject (Bengali/ English/ History/ Pol Science/ Sociology) or vice versa**.
