

B. College and University Level:

Students' week would be observed in all Govt. and Govt. Aided colleges / Universities / Educational Institutions including Technical/ Professional Institutions of the State, in line with the spirit of the programme specially focussing on the facilitation of Student Credit Card camps and other activities like:

- Conducting online seminar / workshop and dissemination of information regarding Student Welfare schemes and other pertinent issues
- Organizing Student Credit Card awareness camp cum help desk
- Organizing awareness camp cum help desk for SVMCM, Aikyashree and Post Metric Scholarship
- Organizing Health Check-up camps and psychological counselling
- Display of IEC materials as determined by competent authority of the State/ District
- Organizing drawing / poster competition
- Quiz Competition
- Cultural programmes like singing competition, recitation competition, creative writing competition.
- Organizing Career Counselling sessions
- Holding seminars on Digital Education or blend mode of education with emphasis on students' participation
- Interaction with the guardians may be planned on 2nd or 3rd January, 2023.
- Interactive exposure visits by School students of Secondary/ Higher secondary classes to different Colleges/ Universities (concerned HOIs may plan in consultation with schools in their catchment areas)

C. District Level:

The programme at District level may plan activities mentioned below for the whole week. The activities taken up during the week may include as follows:

- Organize *Prabhat Pheri*
- Publicity/Awareness regarding the new activities implemented by SED at school level
- Setting up awareness desks on Student Credit Card at the offices of BDOs / SDOs / DM and Local bodies
- Organizing cultural programmes like recitation, reading activities, dance, drama, music, solo act by students and teachers of few selected schools.
- Organizing Book Fair
- Organizing Science exhibitions
- Organizing Stress management workshops / awareness camp for students during the week

4. Monitoring:

The Students' Week intervention will be monitored by the District level Committees and level school wise data will be submitted on a Google Sheet format shared by the State. The DEO/ DI will be in-charge of updating the Google Sheet on a daily basis.

5. Fund Provision:

For conducting the programme at school level, the expenditure may be borne out of School Composite Grant Head of **SSA fund**. Concerned ADM (Education) SSM of each district may place requisition of fund to the State office, if so needed.

For College and University level celebration, expenditure to be born out of available funds at their end.

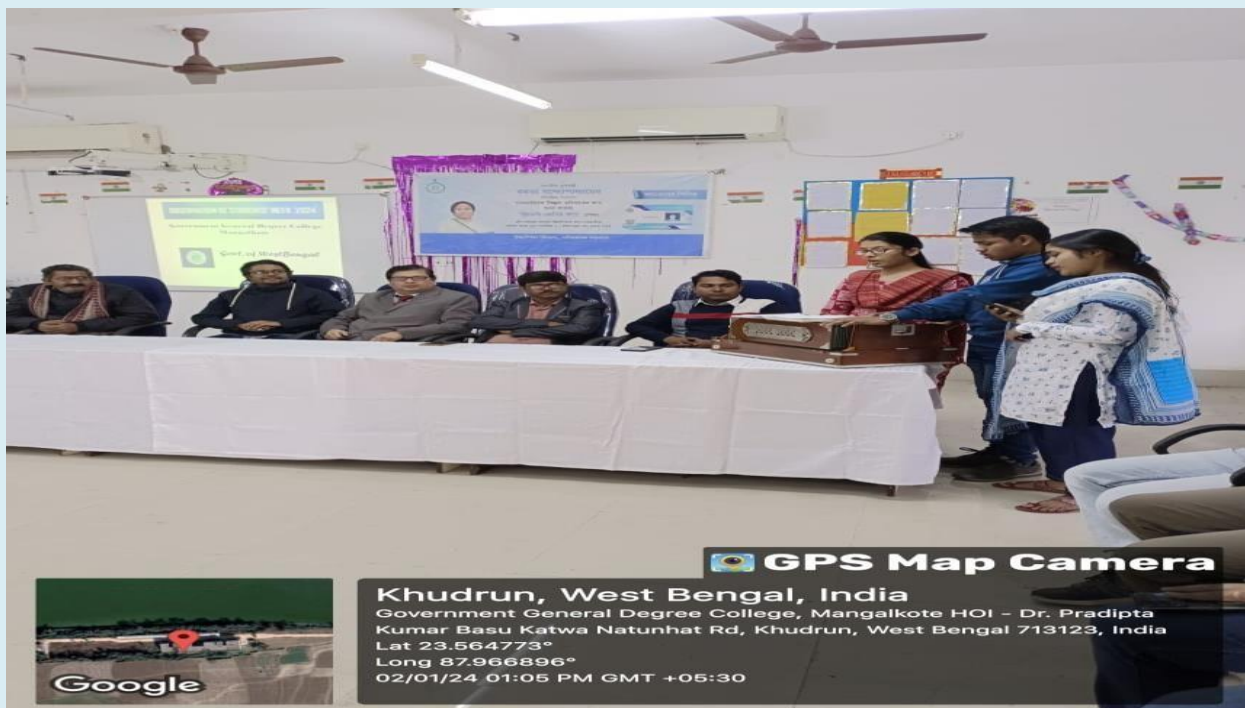

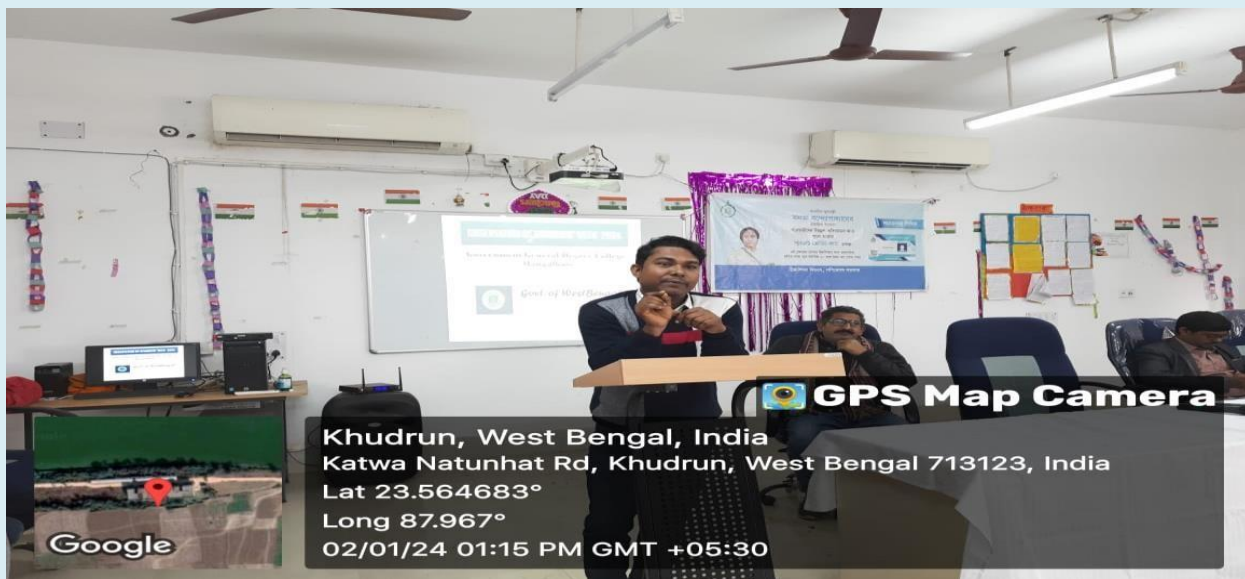

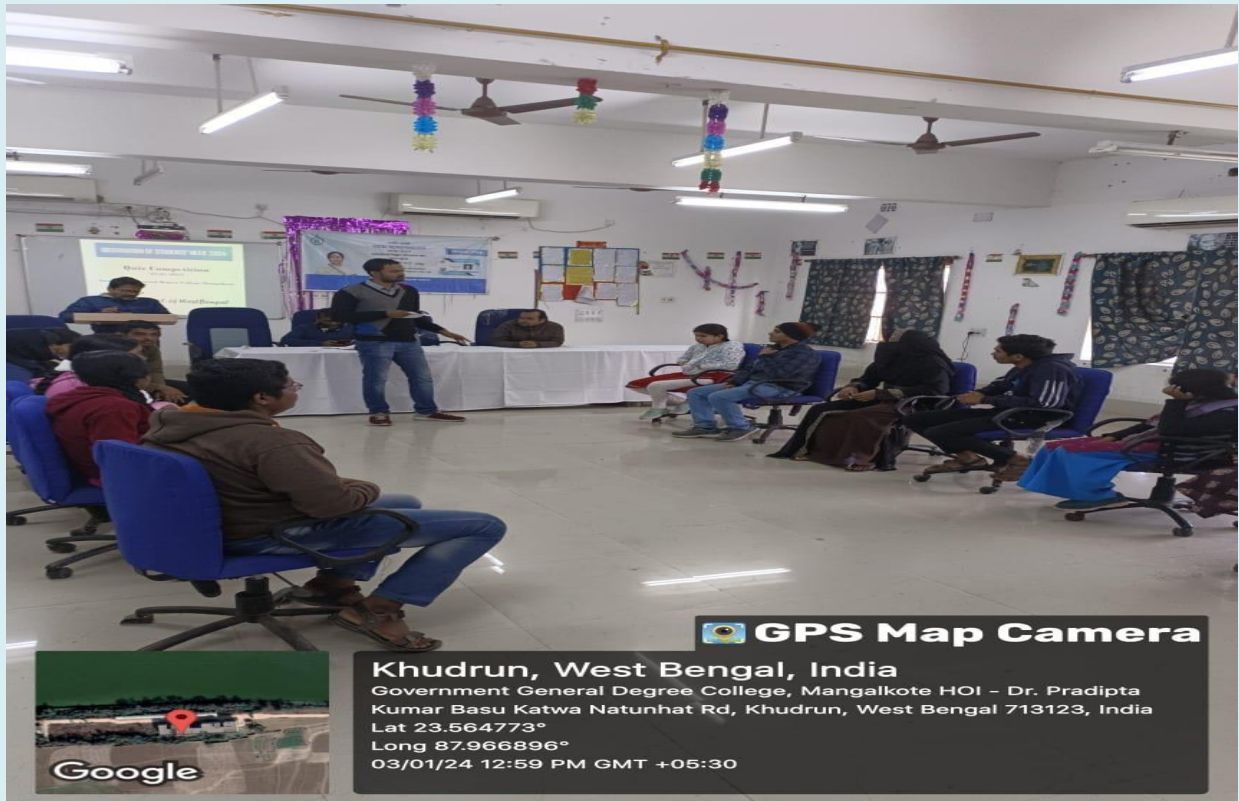

BRIEF SUMMARY OF DR. DEBRAJ BISWAL'S TALK:

This talk traced the evolutionary trajectory of online education focusing on the constituent elements, potentials, problems and barriers related to online education. The speaker discussed the various elements of online education – content sources, web collaboration resources and human resources. Among the potentials or benefits of the online education, the speaker listed learner-centricity, better opportunities, cost-effectiveness, scope for interaction, global knowledge, accessibility, flexibility and learners control on study time. The speaker foregrounded the lack of face-to-face interaction, procrastination, limited hands-on experience, technical glitches, less personalized instruction and questionable credibility of online institutions as the problems of online education. Among barriers to online education, the speaker listed attitude, skills, resources, institutional support, network connectivity and language barrier. The talk concluded with emphasis on the changing nature of teaching-learning process in the wake of technologization of education and the need for adaptation, balance and groundedness in pedagogic practices.

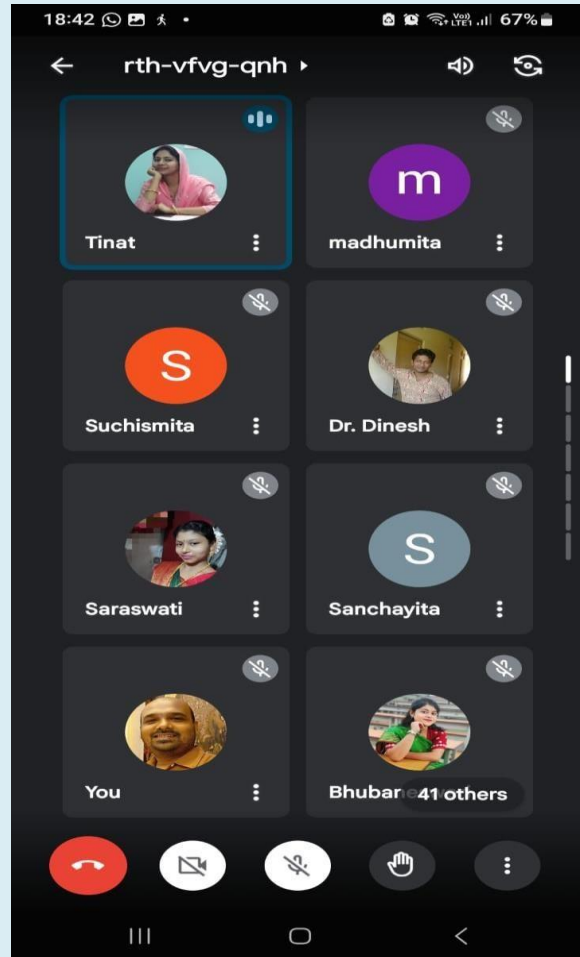
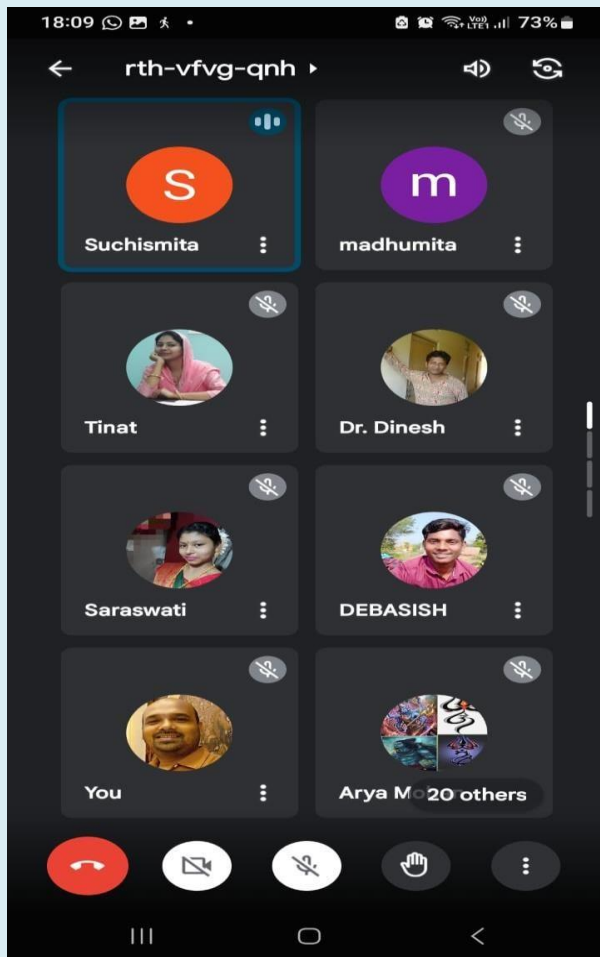

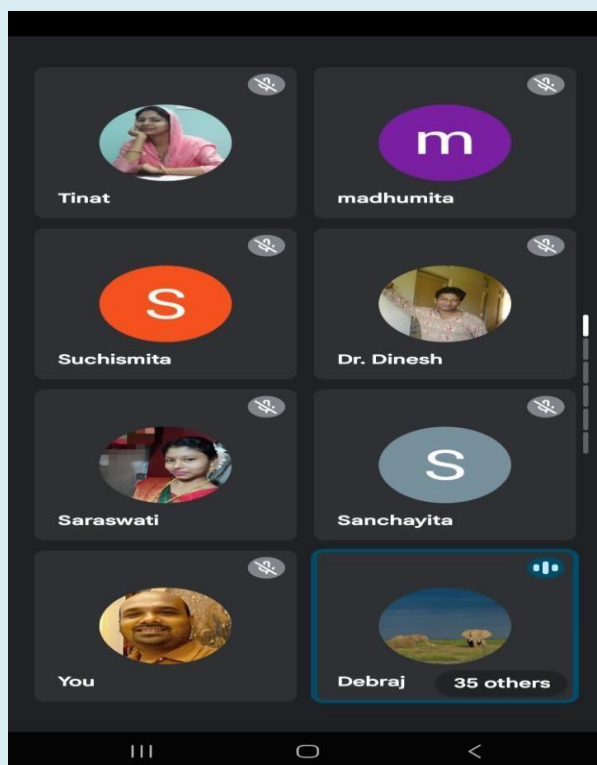

BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE ONLINE PANEL DISCUSSION

The interactive session that dealt with the issue of girl child's right to education as a measure to combat the problem of early marriage or child marriage. Dr. Suchismita Das discussed about the various reasons that lead to early/child marriage. She pointed out to age and fertility problems as limiting factors that persuades parents to marry off their wards early, especially in rural and economically backward areas. Then there is lack of aspiration among youngsters in situations where lack of education, socio-economic backwardness and gender bias go hand in hand. Social norms and practices and gender biases are major evils leading to early marriages. Ms Tinat Rukshana dealt with the remedies of early/child marriage. Equality of opportunity, quality education, self and societal awareness, cultural and family matters and access to social and economic resources are major factors that can contribute to the betterment of situation so far as the girl child's future is concerned. The panel discussion ended with an interactive session with the students and valuable observations from the IQAC Coordinator.

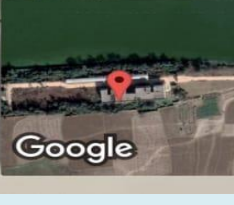

BRIEF SUMMARY OF MR. KESHAB CHANDRA SAHA'S TALK:

The college life of a student is more emotionally and intellectually challenging than any other stage of life. At this stage the student faces a great deal of pressures and physical, emotional and social challenges. As a result they become prone to mental health problems. The speaker cited the various reasons behind depression and mental health issues among the youth these days. He enlightened the students about the various ways of coping with mental health crises posed by various stages and spheres of life. The speaker alluded to 'Apur Sangsar' to explain how destructive depression can be. He advised that suicide should never figure in the list of options available to a student. Rather the student should try to overcome the hurdles and reach out to near and dear ones when in crisis owing to relationship or career related problems. He speaker urged the students to understand that mental health issues are serious and can convert into illness unless addressed or tackled effectively.

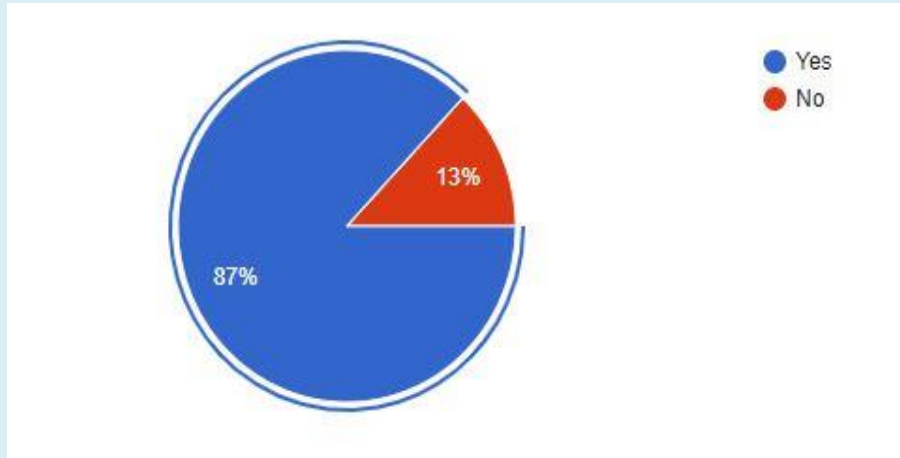

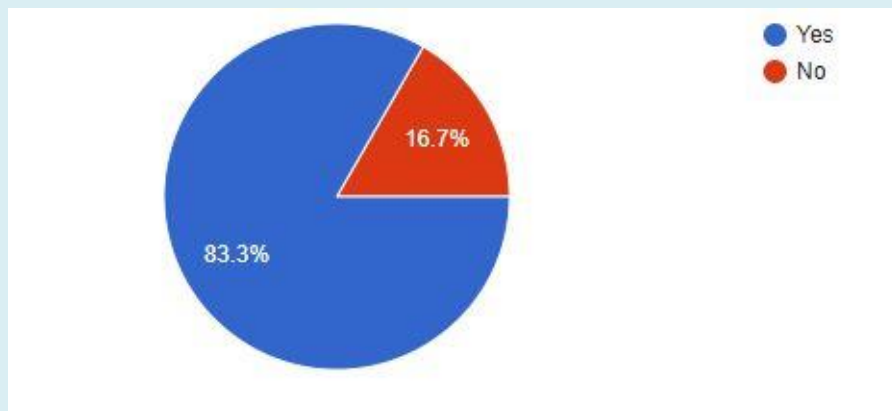

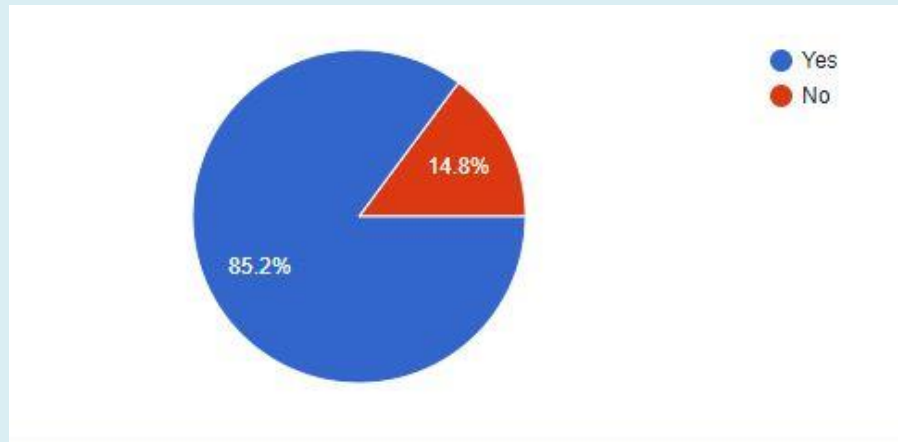

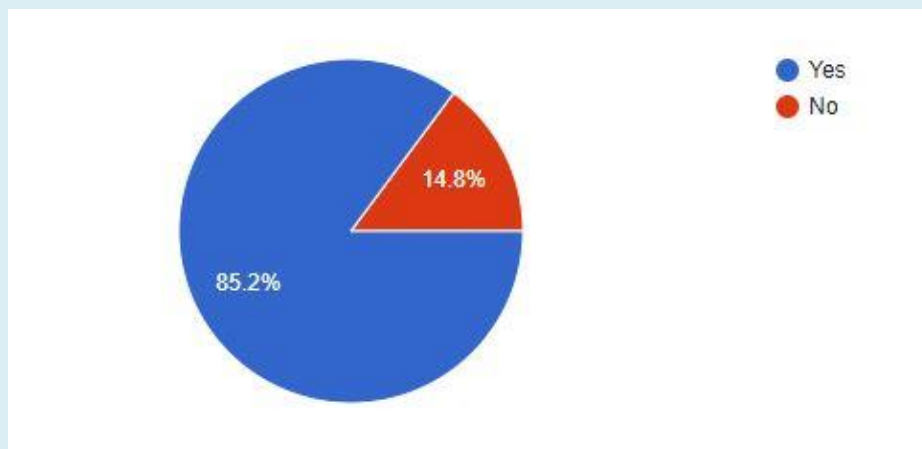

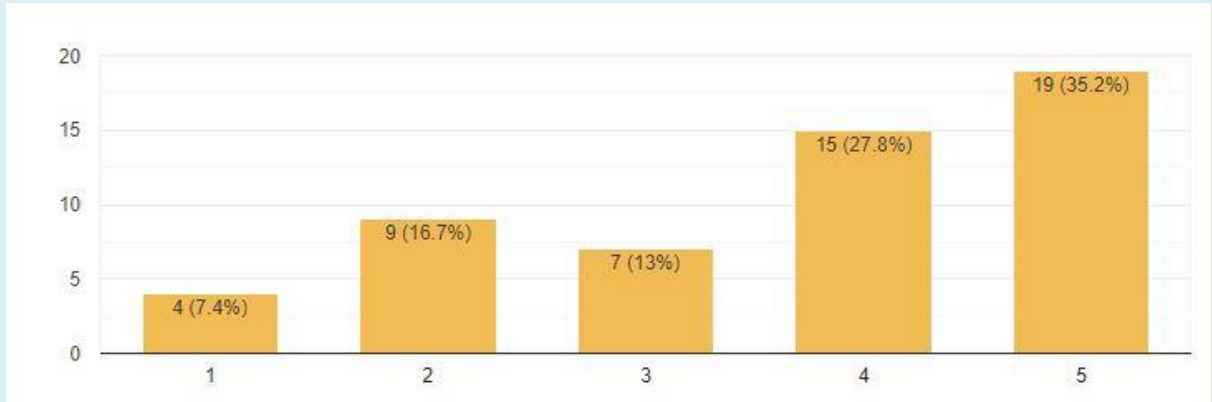
