About World Thinking Day

On this day, Girl Scouts and Girl Guides everywhere will honour their global community by doing activities around this year's special theme on environmental sustainability and alleviation of poverty. Workshop Details

This is a three-day workshop for girl students towards environmental sustainability and alleviation of poverty which will be conducted in three phases.

Phase 1: Each department must nominate minimum two girls within 27.01.2024 and the nominated girls must register themselves using the link https://docs.google.com/forms/d/14RdkzLHDkqeeiP0oGcqV 2XtCGsqL95flrZ9BpTiX50M/edit. The nominated girls will then be required to collect all the discarded papers and other recyclable materials from the various departments, office and college premises within 30.01.2024.

<u>Phase 2:</u> After collection the girls will then create various artefacts and reusable items from the recyclable materials. Time period for this phase is from 01.02.2024 to 20.02.2024.

Phase 3: Finally, the girls will exhibit the items they have created and distribute them to various departments of the college on 22.02.2024. Thus, promoting reusability and sustainability, and also alleviating poverty through various skills they have acquired through the workshop on World Thinking Day.
