#### Aims and objectives of the program

On 26.06.2021, the Department of Sociology in collaboration with IQAC, GGDC, Mangalkote, organized two web-lectures on Google meet to keep the culture of learning alive during the gloomy Covid days.

The first lecture was delivered by Mr. Debottam Saha, PhD Research Scholar, Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, IIT, Delhi. The web-lecture was titled *Taking Ecology Seriously: Ideas, Politics and Movement.* 

The second lecture was delivered by Dr. Sinjini Roy, Assistant Professor in Sociology, Dr. A. P. J. Abdul Kalam Government College, New Town, Kolkata. The weblecture was titled *Different Perspectives to the Study of Family*.

The objective of the programme was to familiarize the students with latest conceptual debates and empirical research work in the sub-disciplinary domains of Environmental Sociology and Sociology of Family, both of which are parts of the CBCS Curriculum of BA Sociology Honours and General courses of the University of Burdwan.

#### **Proceedings of the program**


The web-lecture delivered by Mr. Debottam Saha revolved around conceptual complexities in thinking about ecology and environment. Then he delved deep into the ideas and ideologies associated with contemporary environmental politics and movements. His web-lecture was imbued with references from his on-going PhD research work on organic farming in the Burdwan district. The web-lecture delivered by Dr. Sinjini Roy revolved around the various approaches to the study of family and kinship. Her web-lecture focused on her PhD research on Social Gerontology attempting to establish the fact that the dependency crisis of the aged in the contemporary society need not be looked at from the point of view of neglect by the younger generation but in terms of greater mutual understanding between the aged and the dependent on the one hand and the younger generation on the other.

#### **Participants**

About thirty students, both internal and external, participated in the web-lecture. About twelve teachers also participated in the web-lecture. Apart from the teachers and students from the college, there were participants from Chandernagore College, Department of Social Work, Viswa Bharati University, Hyderabad Central University, Presidency University, St. Xavier's College, Mumbai.

#### **Result of the program**

The feedback collected from the respondents show that all the participants rated the two web-lectures either 4 or 5, which indicates high evaluation of the contents of the web-lecture by the participants. All participants responded that they benefited immensely from the programme. Most of the participants stated that the lectures were excellent or great. They praised the arrangement of the programme and requested the organizers to continue the initiative.
