

OBJECTIVE OF THE PROGRAMME:


- -To raise awareness about HIV/AIDS among students.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE PROGRAMME:

- Lecture on the topic '**HIV/AIDS AWARENESS AND SOCIETY**' featuring Dr. Amit Kumar Rakshit, at Government General Degree College, Mangalkote, was an insightful and informative session.
- Dr. Raksit began by highlighting the significance of understanding HIV/AIDS in the context of society, emphasizing that it is not merely a medical issue but a social and economic one as well. He explained how HIV/AIDS affects not only the individual but also their families, communities, and the broader society. The speaker discussed the epidemiology of HIV/AIDS, its transmission modes, and the importance of prevention strategies like condom use, safe blood transfusions, and harm reduction. He also touched upon the stigma and discrimination faced by people living with HIV/AIDS, which often leads to social isolation, low self-esteem, and poor adherence to treatment. Dr. Raksit stressed that addressing these underlying factors is crucial to preventing the spread of HIV/AIDS and ensuring effective treatment and care. Throughout the lecture, Dr. Raksit used engaging visuals, statistics, and real-life examples to illustrate his points, making the session



- interactive and informative for the students and faculty members in attendance. His concluding remarks emphasized the importance of empathy, compassion, and a comprehensive approach to addressing HIV/AIDS in our society. Dr. Amit Kumar Raksit's lecture provided a comprehensive overview of HIV/AIDS, its social implications, and the need for a collective response to address this critical public health issue.


NO. OF PARTICIPANT ATTENDED THE PROGRAMME: 40

- Improved Health Literacy: Participants developed a better understanding of the importance of health literacy, recognizing its impact on overall well-being and disease management.

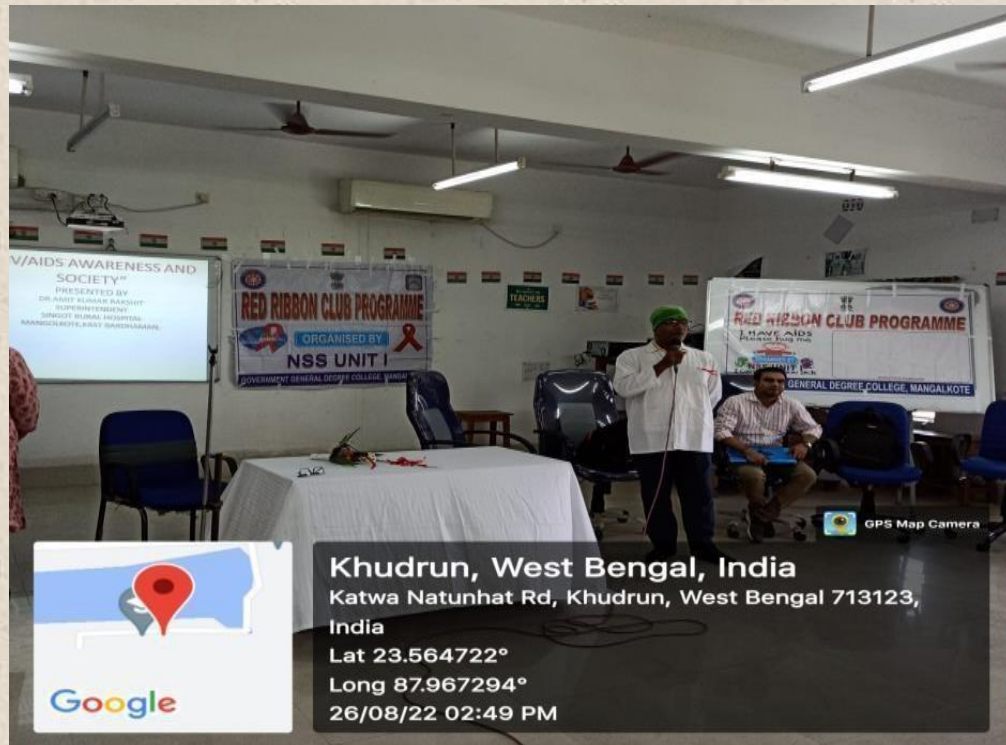


- The program successfully achieved its objectives, empowering the students with knowledge, empathy, and a commitment to addressing HIV/AIDS in their communities.





Both the parties herein have noted the importance of the value of cooperation and have agreed to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) regarding medical collaboration. The purpose of this non-binding MoU is to make possible medical and healthcare facilities between both the parties based on the principles of mutual equality and the reciprocity of benefits. 1. Objectives, Scope, and Major Activities

Both the parties agree to encourage the development of the following types of activities:

- To provide doctors for emergency check up of the students when necessary.
- To arrange half yearly medical check-up camps.
- To provide guidance regarding medical issues and cure of the patients.
- To provide emergency first aid training of the college staff.
- Organize joint conferences, webinar, symposia or other scientific meetings on subjects of mutual interest.
- Explore the possibilities for developing joint research programs and collaborations.
- To conduct joint outreach activities.
- To provide the treatment on priority basis.

2. Responsibilities of the Institutions

3. Duration and Option to Amend, Extend or Terminate

This MoU will become effective when signed by authorities of both institutions. The agreement will remain in effect for five years from the date of signature given below, and may be renewed or amended by mutual agreement of the institutions. The institutions should agree to periodically review the activities undertaken and the progress made and to consult concerning amendments, renewal or termination of this MoU. Either authority may terminate this MoU at any time by providing written notice prior to three months before such termination to the other authority.

4. General Terms

This MoU is not intended to, and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable by law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents. Nothing in this MoU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support of projects or activities between the two parties. Neither party will use the name of the other, either expressly or by implication, in any publicity, solicitation or advertisement without the express written approval of the other party to this MoU.

5. Signatures

This MoU is valid for 5 years and shall enter into force on the date of the signing by qualified representatives of both parties.
