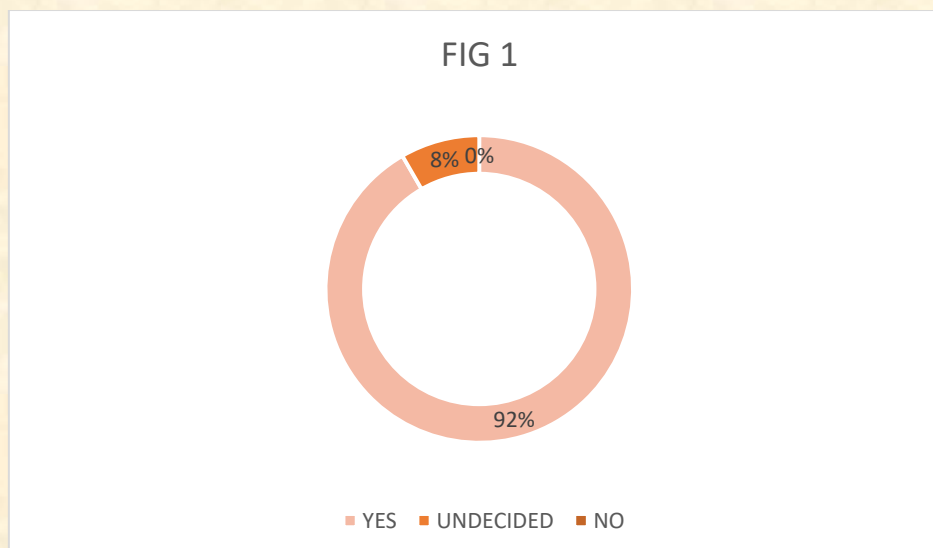

ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2018-2019

Introduction: Alumni feedback survey bears much significance in terms of bringing out the strengths and weaknesses of the institution. The alumnus i.e. the students who have already passed out from the college are the best judge of the academic environment, support system, campus facilities and other features of the institution. The alumni survey that was conducted in the session 2018-19, consisted of the first batch of students that graduated from GGDC, Mangalkote. This report is based on the feedback collected from 12 students who have graduated in the year 2018. The survey contained important questions on teaching-learning process, the use of ICT tools by the teachers, redressal of grievances received and the like. The following report contains an analysis of the major responses.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

- **THE TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS IS SATISFACTORY**



The above figure shows that 92% of the respondents are of the opinion that the teaching-learning process in the college have been satisfactory. While a miniscule 8% are rather unsure of their opinion regarding the matter.

- **TEACHERS USE STUDENT-CENTRIC METHOD**

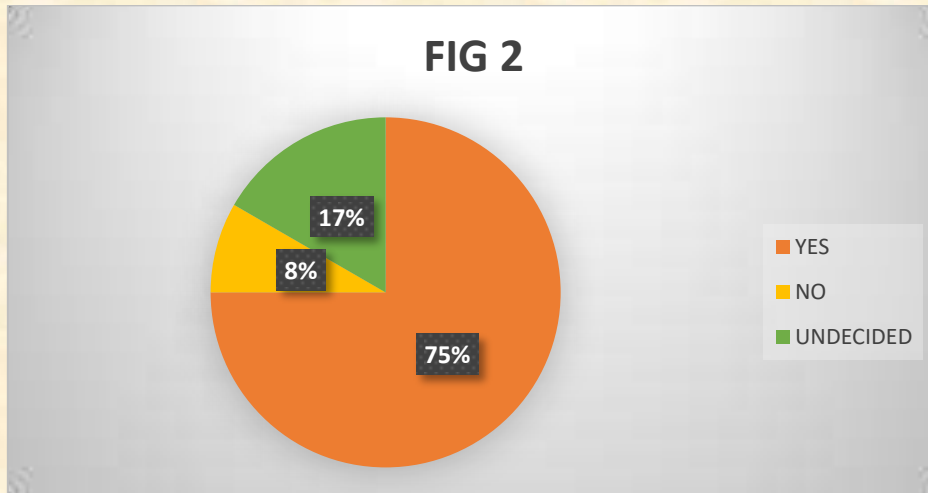
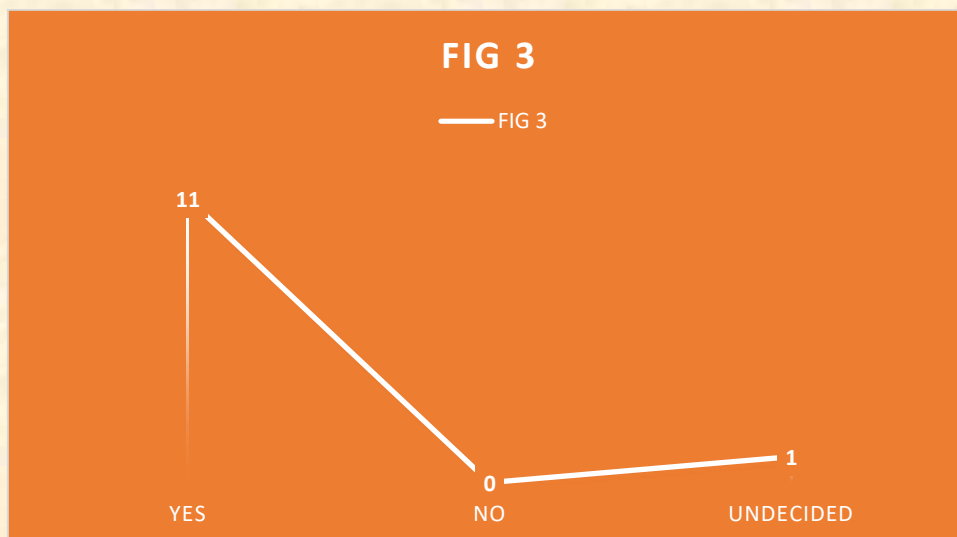


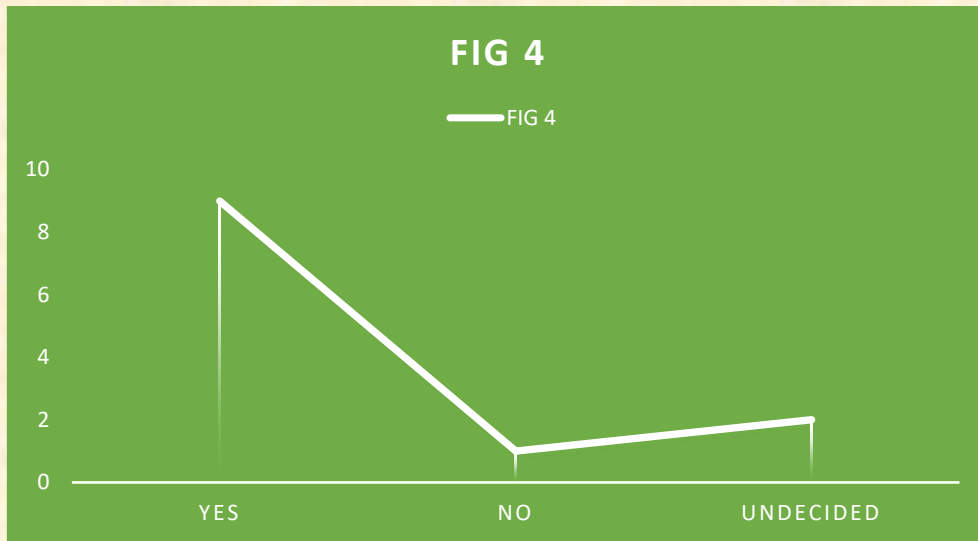

- **CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT THROUGH ADD-ON COURSES AND SEMINARS**



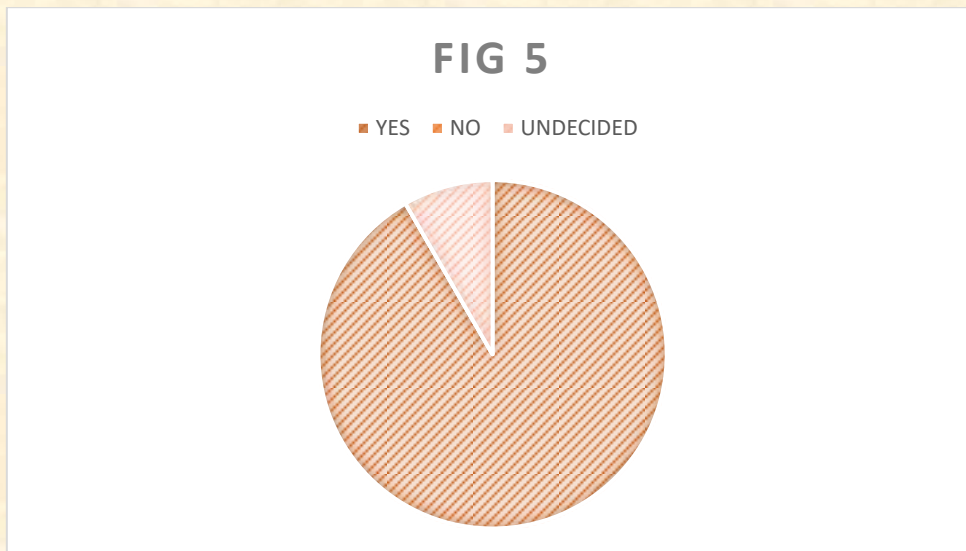
As is evident from Fig 3, almost all the respondents are of the opinion that classroom teaching has been augmented by Add-on courses and seminars.

The above figure clearly shows that a majority of the respondents have positive opinion regarding the redressal of students' grievances by the institution, while a small minority have also opined that they are unsure of this dimension.

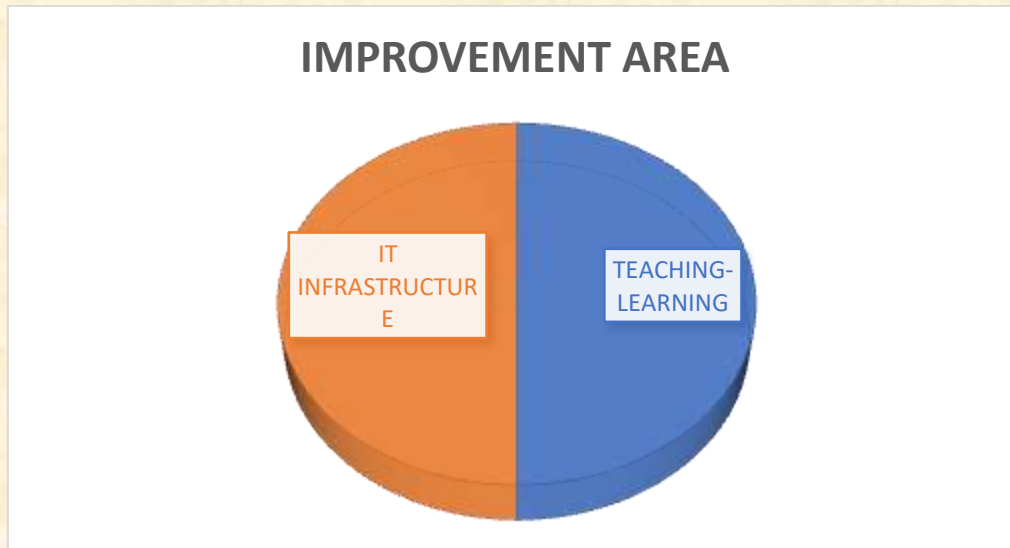
- **RECREATIONAL AND SPORT FACILITIES**
