### 1. THE TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS IS SATISFACTORY

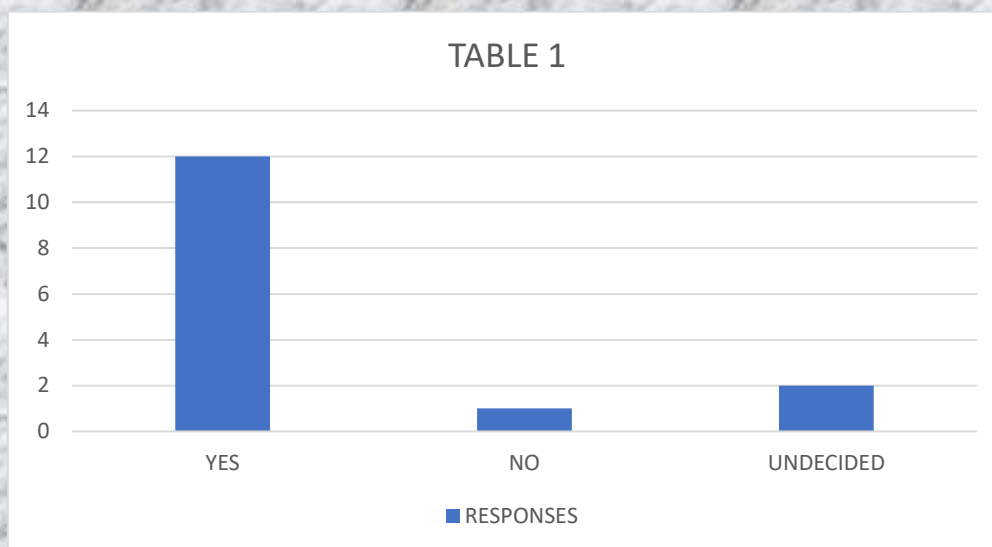
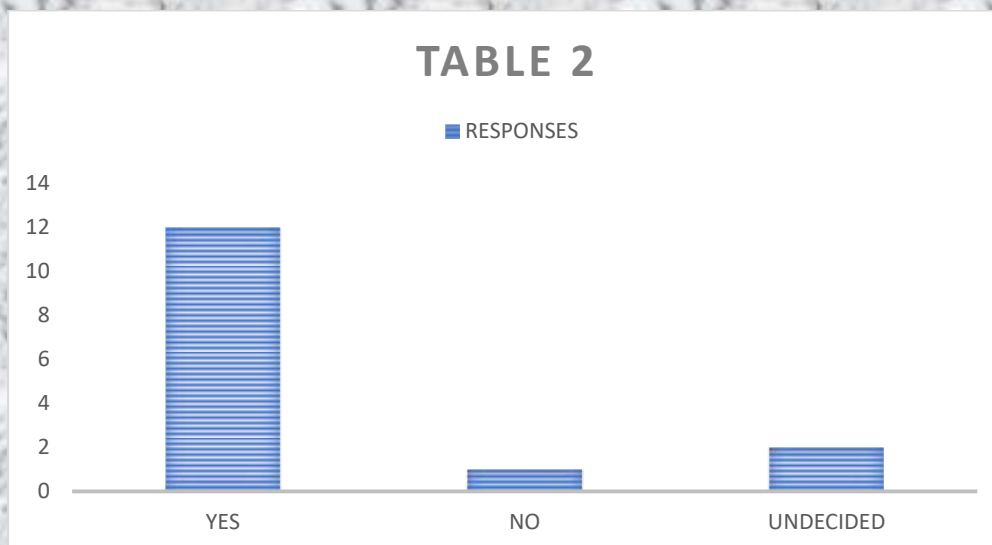


Table 1 clearly shows that a majority of the respondents think that the teaching-learning process in the college is satisfactory.

## 3. TEACHERS USE ICT-ENABLED TOOLS

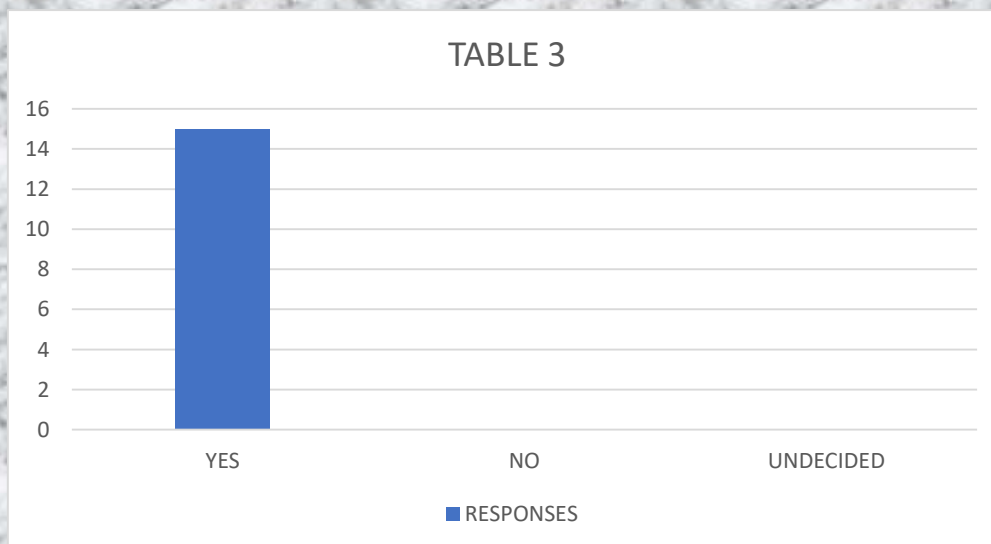


Table 3 shows that all the respondents are satisfied that the faculty members make good use of ICT tools here in teaching-learning.



#### 4. CURRICULUM ENRICHMENT THROUGH ADD-ON COURSES AND SEMINARS

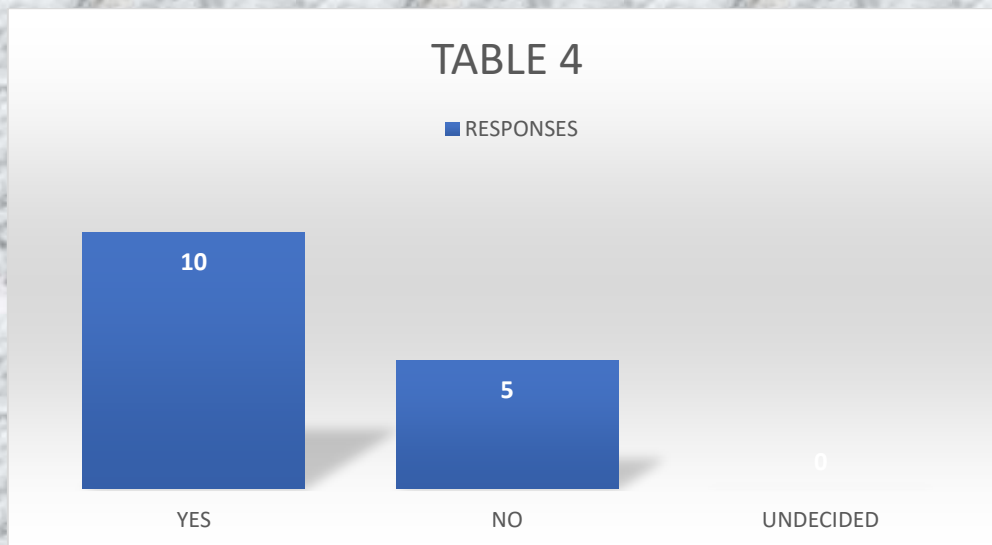
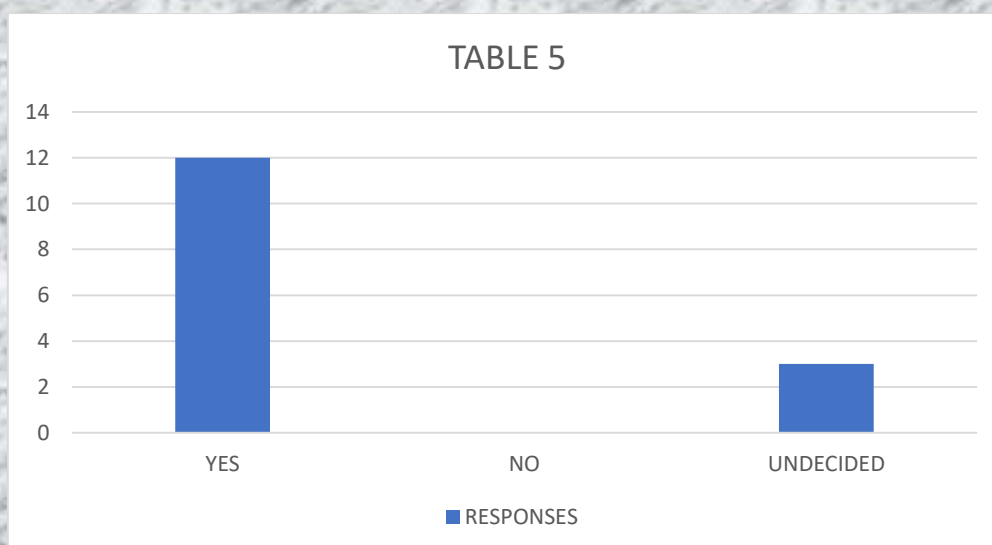


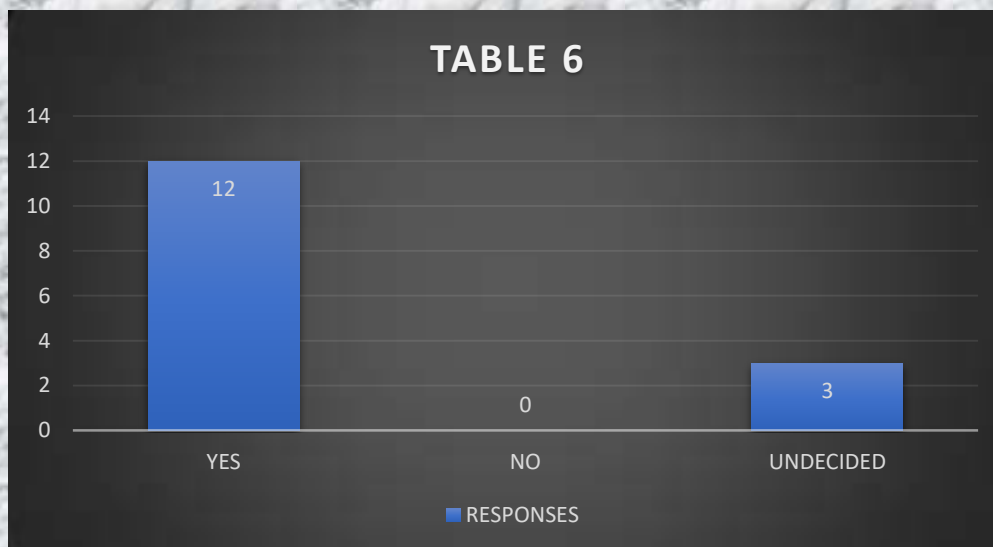

## 7. SPORTS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

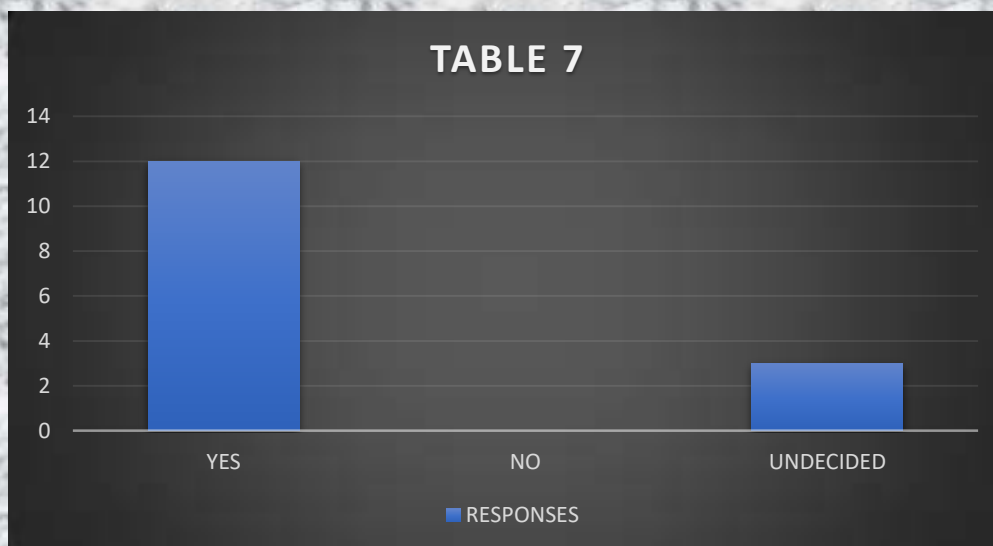
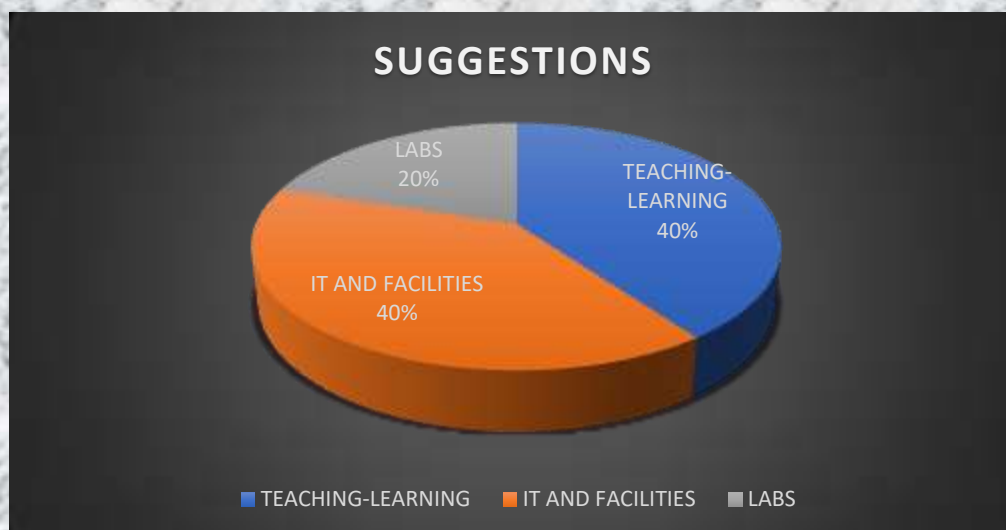


Table 7 clearly shows that the majority of the respondents are of the opinion that sports and recreational facilities are available at the college.
