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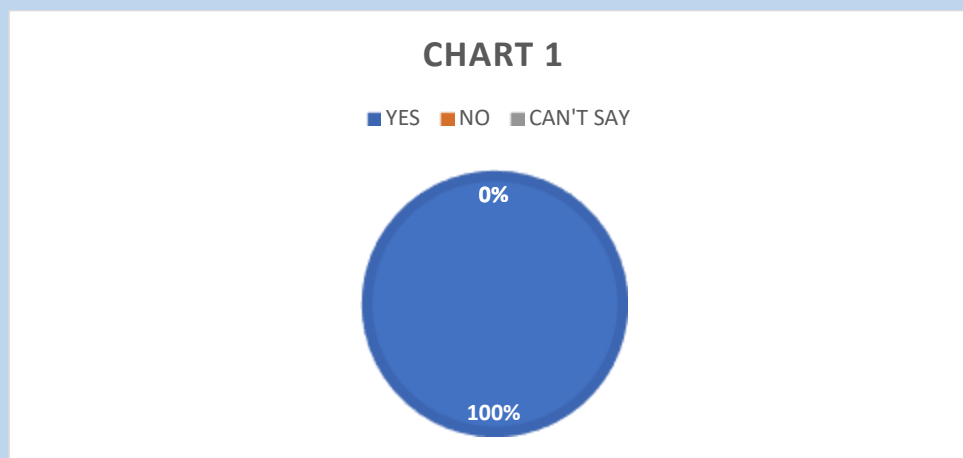
PARENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT

1. TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS IS SATISFACTORY

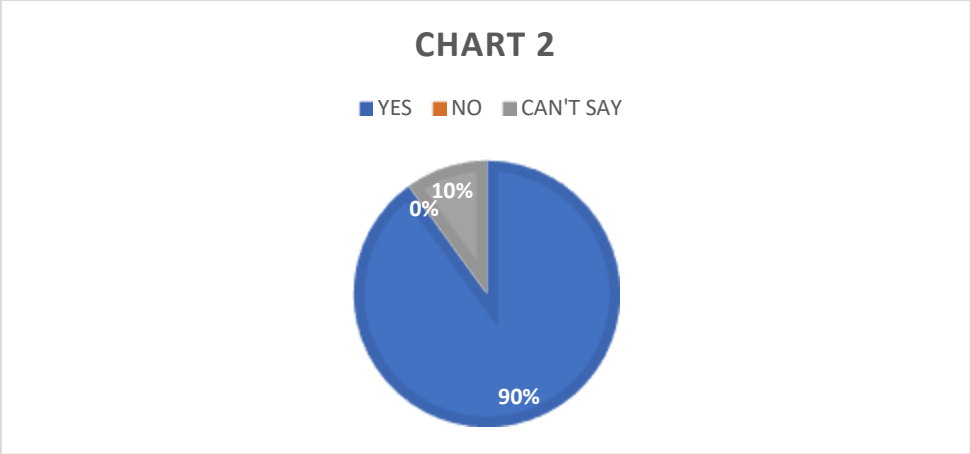


As is evident from Chart 1 that 100% of the respondents are of the opinion that the teaching-learning process at GGDCM is satisfactory and effective.

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A majority of the respondents are of the opinion that the faculty members use participatory and student-centric methods in classroom teaching while 10% are rather unsure of their opinion.

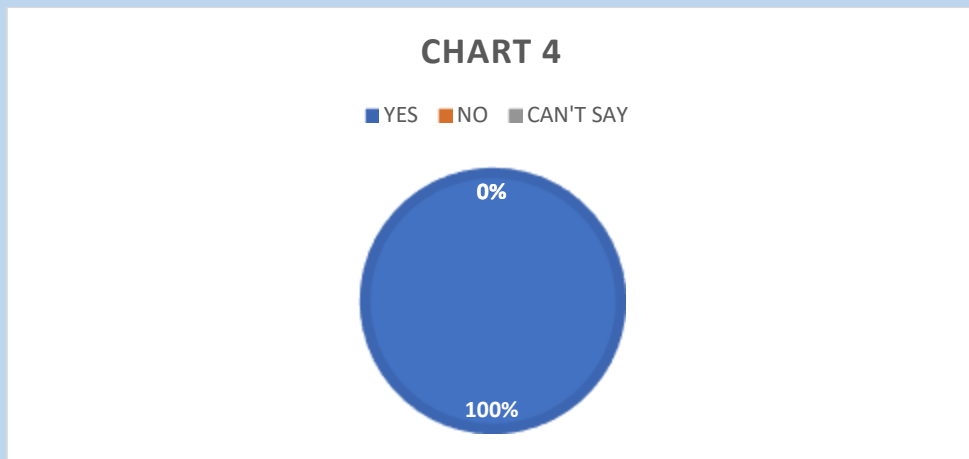
3. TEACHERS PROVIDE FEEDBACK ON PERFORMANCE AND PROGRESSION



It is evident from the above chart that all the respondents are of the opinion that the faculty members at the GGDCM provide regular feedback to their students regarding their performance.

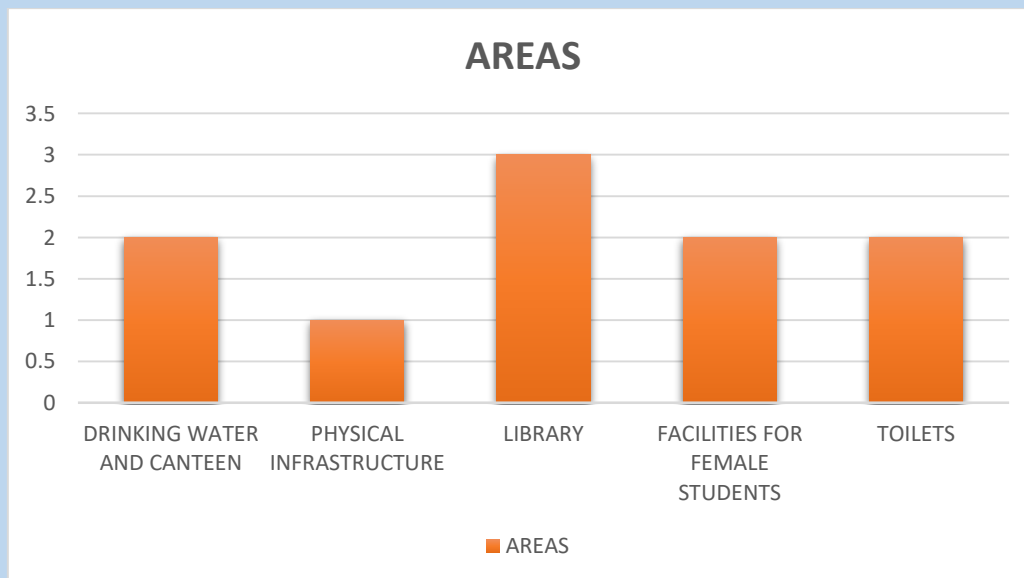
4. SAFETY AND SECURITY WITHIN THE CAMPUS IS PRIORITIZED
