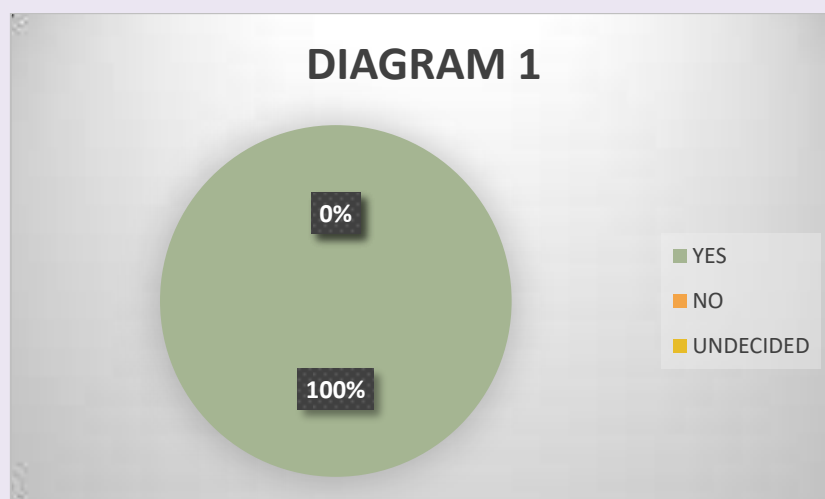

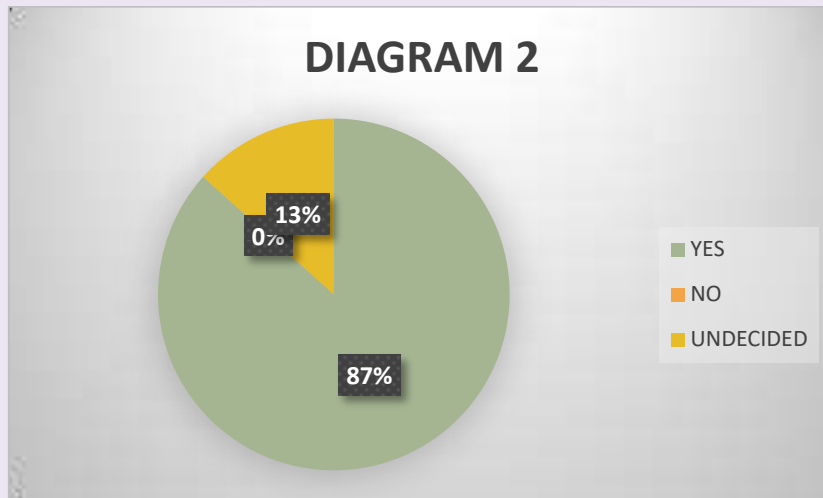

- **THE TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS IS SATISFACTORY**



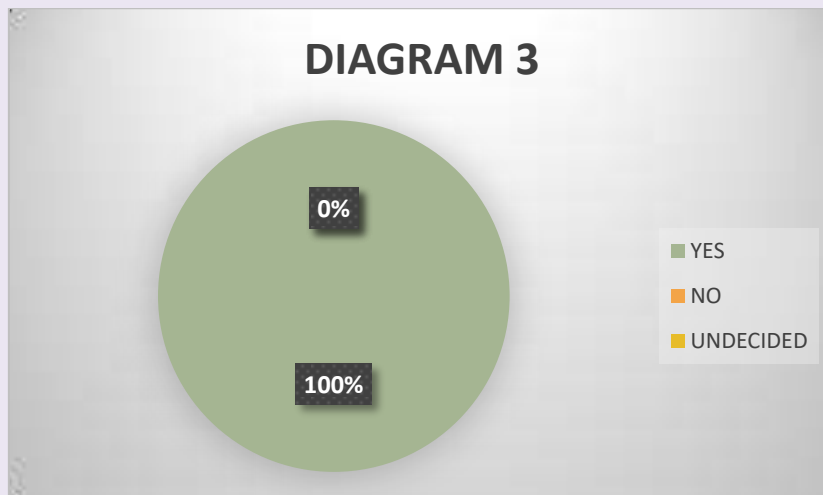
100% of the respondents are of the opinion that the teaching-learning process is satisfactory.

- **TEACHERS USE STUDENT-CENTRIC METHODS**



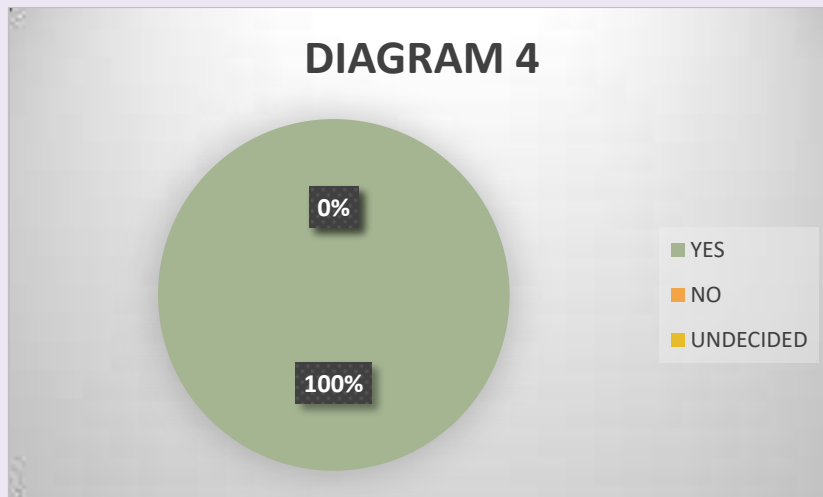
87% of the respondents think that the teachers use student-centric methods, while 13% are rather unsure.

- **TEACHERS USE ICT-ENABLED TOOLS**



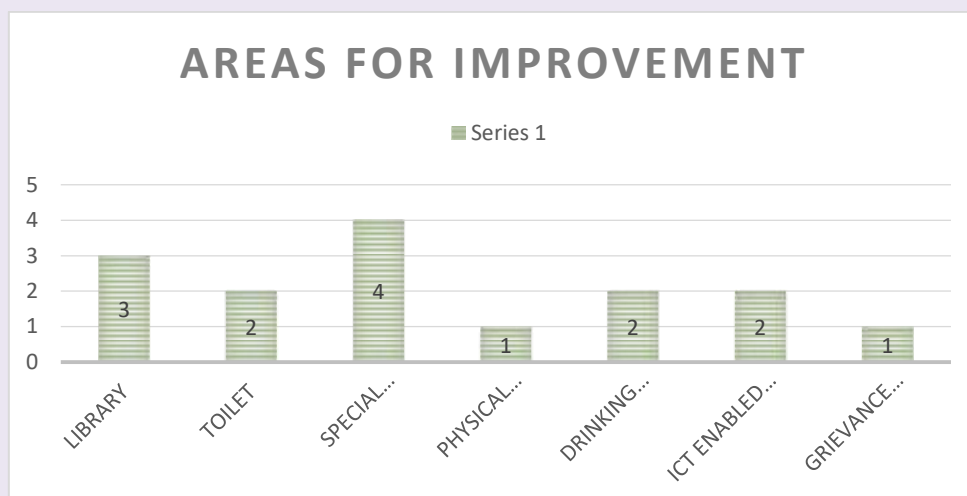
All the respondents are of the opinion that the faculty members use ICT-enabled tools in teaching-learning.
